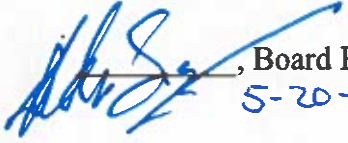

**Klickitat Valley Health – Special Board Meeting Summary  
Topic: Community Health Improvement Plan**

- Discussion of the organization’s Strategic Plan, aligned with findings from the Community Health Needs Assessment (CHNA).
- Review of KVH’s Mission and Vision to ensure alignment with community health priorities.
- Development of an actionable, three-year implementation plan, including preliminary frameworks for execution.
- Emphasis on Behavioral Health, including crisis response and prevention strategies.
- Evaluation of Emergency Room operations, with particular focus on reducing wait times.
- Identification of key focus areas:
  - Community engagement and education
  - Preventive screenings
  - Addressing social determinants of health (e.g., transportation barriers)
- Exploration of external opportunities and partnerships, including collaboration with local resources such as the senior center.
- Outline of implementation steps and timelines.
- Plan to prepare and present a draft of the Community Health Improvement Plan to the Board for review and feedback.
